
Could there be a strike at UOIT?

On February 22nd to 25th, we held a strike mandate vote of the Faculty Association's Tenured and Tenure-Track Faculty Members. This is part of a legal process of collective bargaining and means that striking is a legal possibility. **This does not necessarily mean there will be a strike and we are doing everything possible to avert a strike at UOIT.**

Students can stay informed in many ways:

Ask your professors questions. For example, what do they think of the working conditions at UOIT? Are they tenured, tenure-track or teaching-focused faculty? Do they have a continuing appointment or do they have to reapply for their job on an ongoing basis?

The people in front of your classroom deserve fair working conditions in line with those at other Ontario universities. Do you want to go to a University where those guiding you through your academic journey are overworked, underpaid, and underresourced?
