Bargaining Update: November 21, 2013

We bargained yesterday and today the UOIT's administration and have made considerable progress. We have signed off and agreed to articles that deal with Grievance, Appointments, and Continuing Appointment. The Grievance article has taken over a year to develop from the time UOIT tabled it on November 5, 2012.

Many issues are important to the integrity of teaching at UOIT, such as manageable workload, but central is the question of long-term employment security for all colleagues. Both of these key issues (job security and workload) are still in progress; these will take time to develop and we want to develop these with care. Employment security is critical for all Faculty Members and Teaching Faculty deserve nothing less.

Our next round of bargaining will be December 17, 18, and 19.
