TOP TEN REASON'S TO BE ELECTED TO THE UOITFA EXECUTIVE

10. Many of the positions do not really require a lot of time on the Member's part. In other words, you get a lot of value, for a little effort.

Consider adding your time to the UOITFA. Below are a list of positions and brief description of their duties:

Faculty Representative. As an FA Rep, you are asked to attend all General Faculty Meetings, for the members of your faculty who are unable to attend because of teaching conflicts, etc. Reps act as a liaison between their Faculty and the FA, listening to the Membership to understand their concerns and to bring the unique issues facing their Faculty Members to the FA. There is one representative for each Faculty here at UOIT.

President: This is the most senior Executive position within the UOITFA. The UOITFA President's duties are many and varied, but essentially act in a leadership role for the organization. The President attends various OCUFA and CAUT meetings and works with the UOITFA Executive to make decisions regarding the FA activities, including representation, bargaining, and so on.

Statistics Canada launched on Monday, March 29, 2010 a new portal on its website: Update on Social Analysis Research (www.statcan.gc.ca/socialanalysis).

The portal provides direct access to analytical work of the Social Analysis Division on topics such as: pensions and retirement, immigration, education and training, labour market adjustment and income and wealth. As users, you will have access to abstracts, executive summaries and full length papers, organized according to specific research topics, improving your Internet browsing experience. The portal also provides summaries of our latest releases.

Criminology, Justice, & Policy Studies (soon to be the Faculty of Social Sciences and Humanities):


