

Could there be a strike at UOIT?

From January 16th to 25th, the UOIT Faculty Association held a Strike Mandate Vote of all Faculty Association Members.

A Strike Mandate Vote is one way for our members to show support for our bargaining team. A Strike Mandate Vote does not necessarily mean there will be a strike – it is one of several steps that have to happen before the Faculty Association can enter into a legal strike position. The Faculty Association will do everything we can to keep the UOIT community informed throughout this process.

At UOIT, faculty working conditions are student learning conditions. Faculty Members need the support of the UOIT community to help remind the Administration that faculty members and our students should be the University's first priority.

Support from students and community members can go a long way in helping us avert a strike at UOIT. Visit our website to send a message to the UOIT Administration telling them to avoid a strike by negotiating a fair deal with the UOIT Faculty Association.
