

Could there be a strike at Ontario Tech?

From October 19 to 22, the UOIT Faculty Association held a strike mandate vote with 90% of faculty in voting in favour.

A strike mandate vote is one way for our members to show support for our bargaining team.

A strike mandate vote does not necessarily mean there will be a strike—it is one of several steps that have to happen before the faculty association can enter into a legal strike position.

The UOITFA will do everything we can to keep the Ontario Tech community informed throughout this process.

At Ontario Tech, faculty working conditions are student learning conditions. We have voted in favour of a strike mandate because we care about our students and the future of the university.

Faculty Members need the support of the Ontario Tech community to help remind the administration that faculty members and our students should be the university's first priority.

Support from students and community members can go a long way in helping us avert a strike at Ontario Tech.
